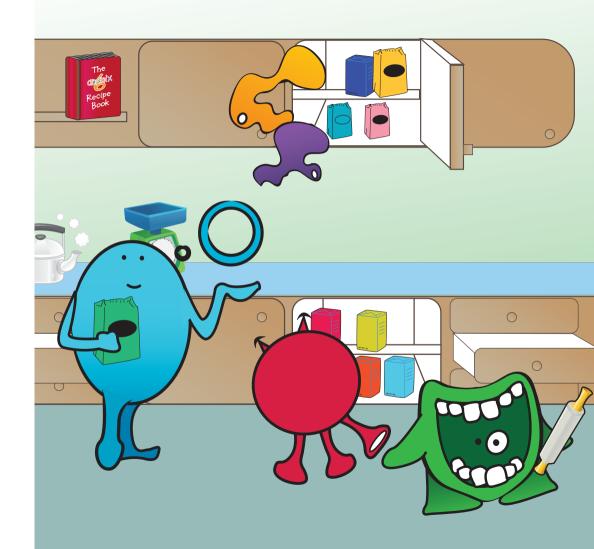


The Cookery Lesson

"Let's get cooking!"

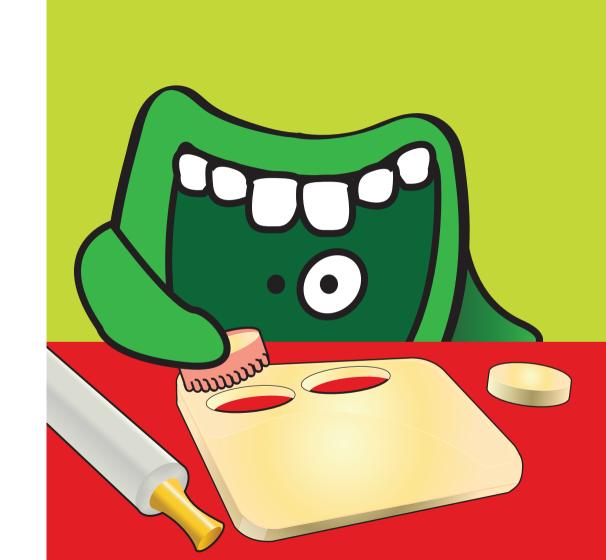
Loprofin Mix and Loprofin Egg Replacer are Food for Special Medical Purposes for use under medical supervision.

"10 minutes feels like a long time when you're as hungry as I am" thought Megabyte.



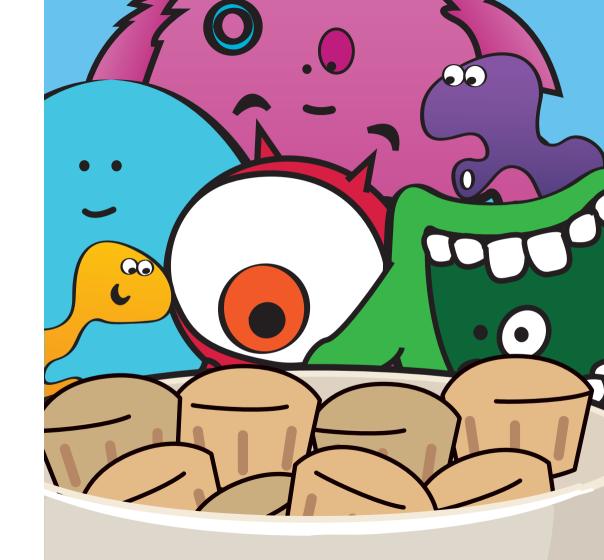
Finally the scones were cooked! The teacher helped to take them out of the oven.
