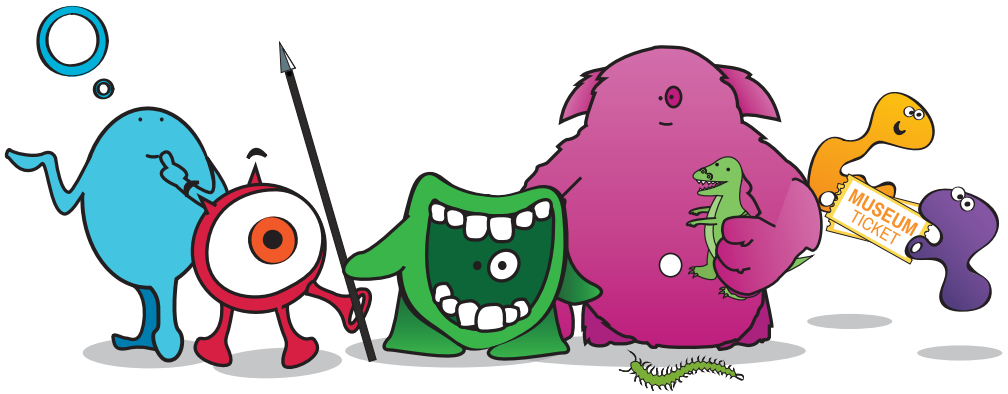


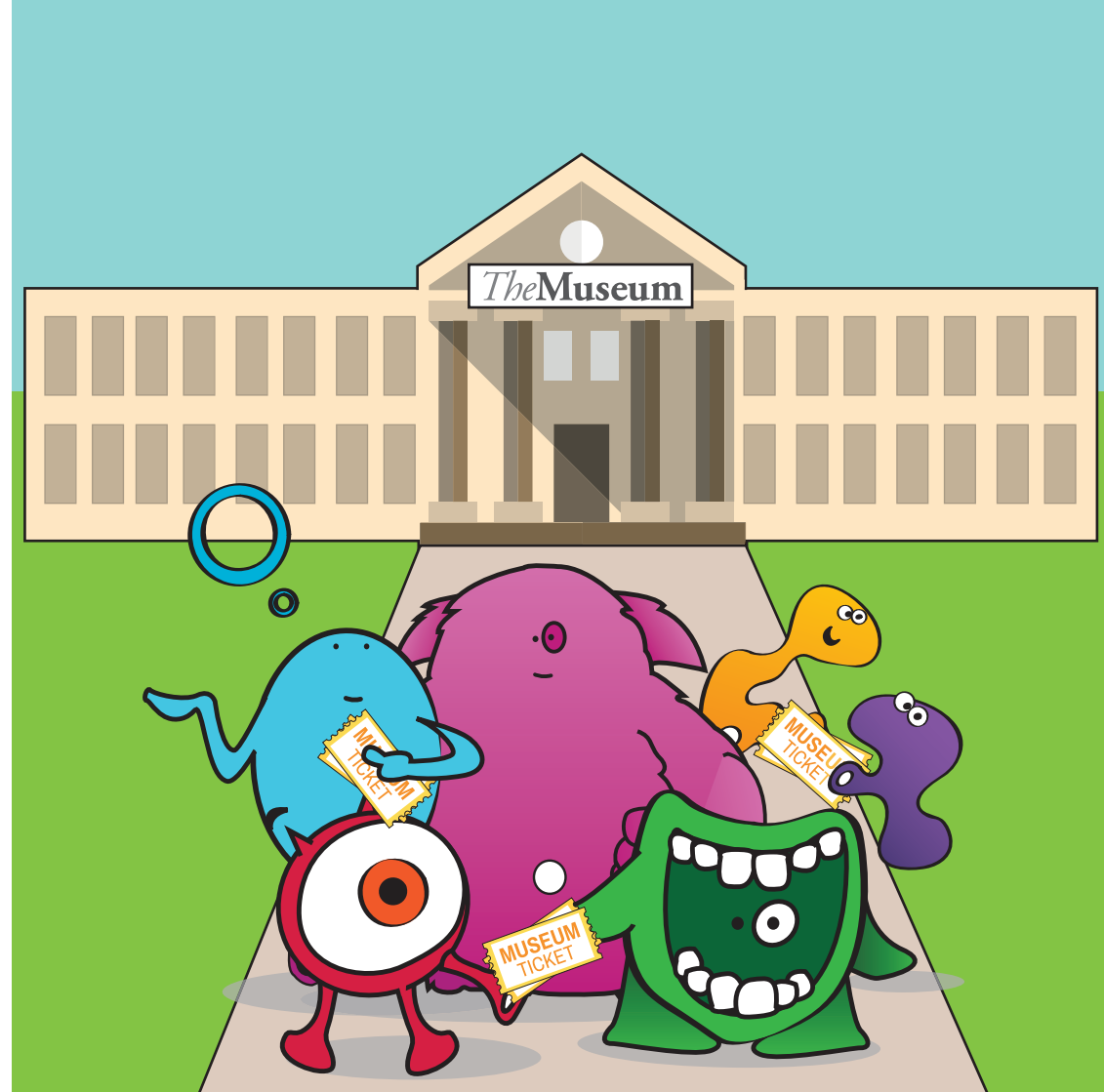

They are going to spend the day at the museum!



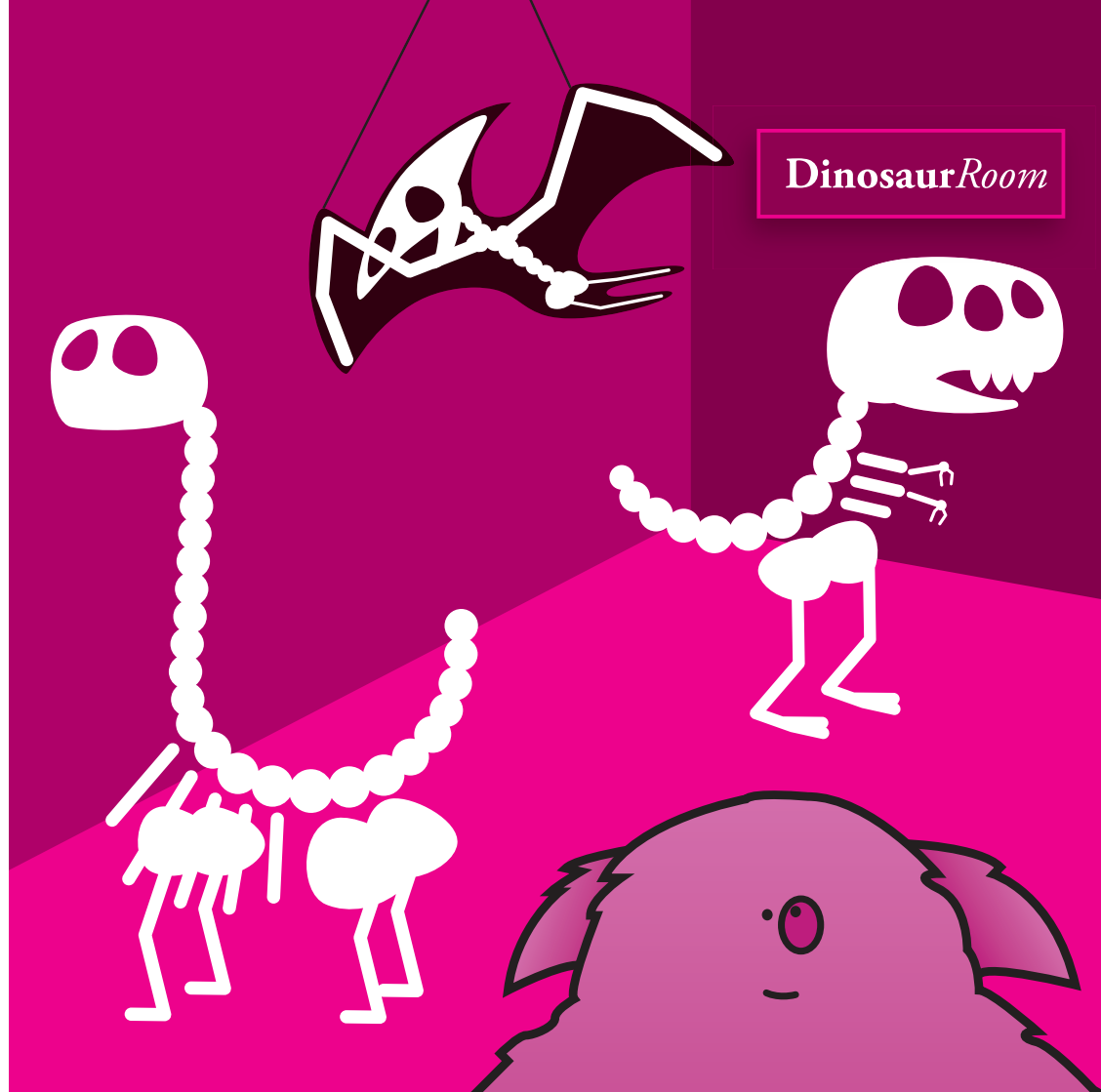
First stop at the museum is Bones' favourite.

The Anamix 6 all laughed and moved on to the next room in the museum...

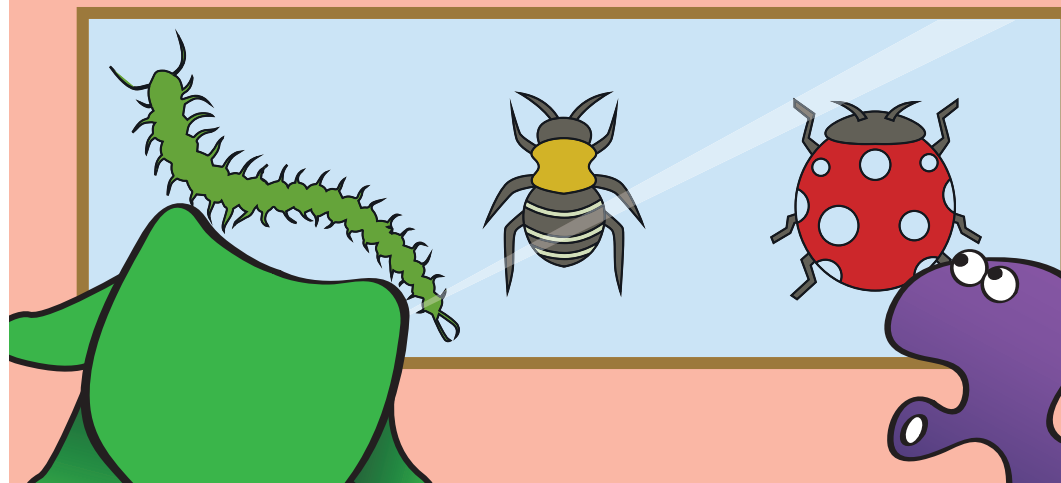
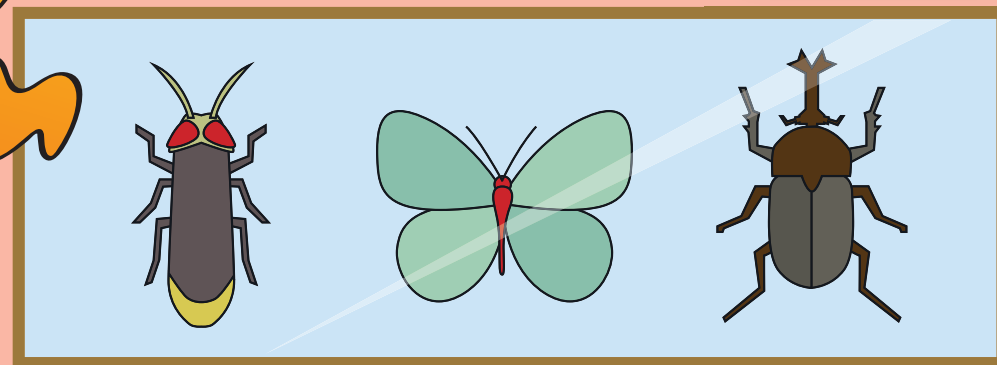
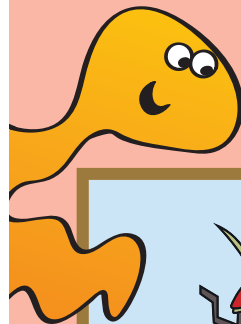


The Omega Twins have always been fascinated with creepy crawlies! That's why The Insect Room was their favourite bit of the museum.

"Maybe we should go to the next room now?" said Megabyte, who had been trying to count the legs on a giant milipede.



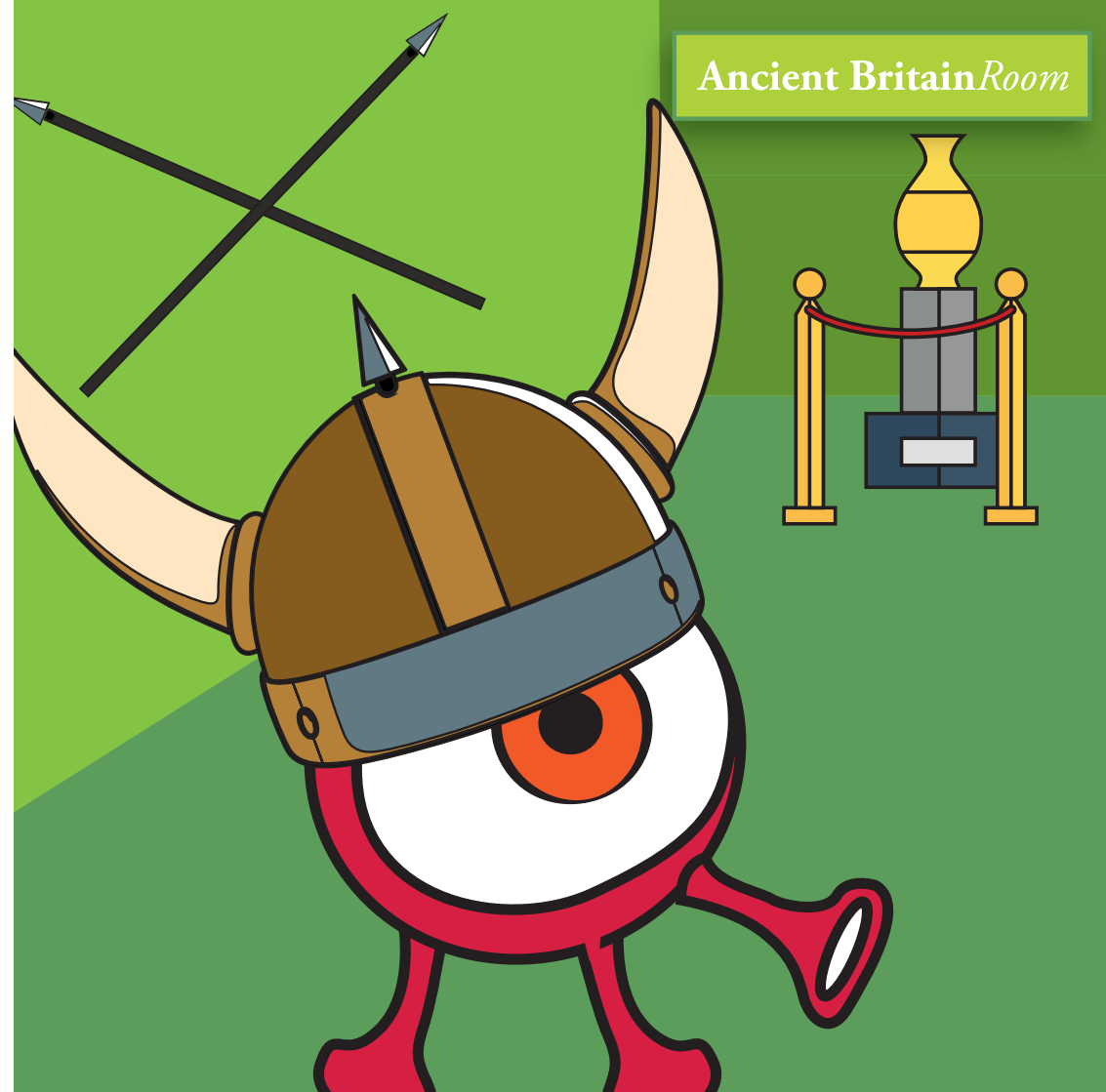
The Ancient Britain Room was next. This was definitely Big Eye's favourite place!

"Or maybe he just likes the fancy hats!" said Megabyte, who was leading the way to the next room in the museum.



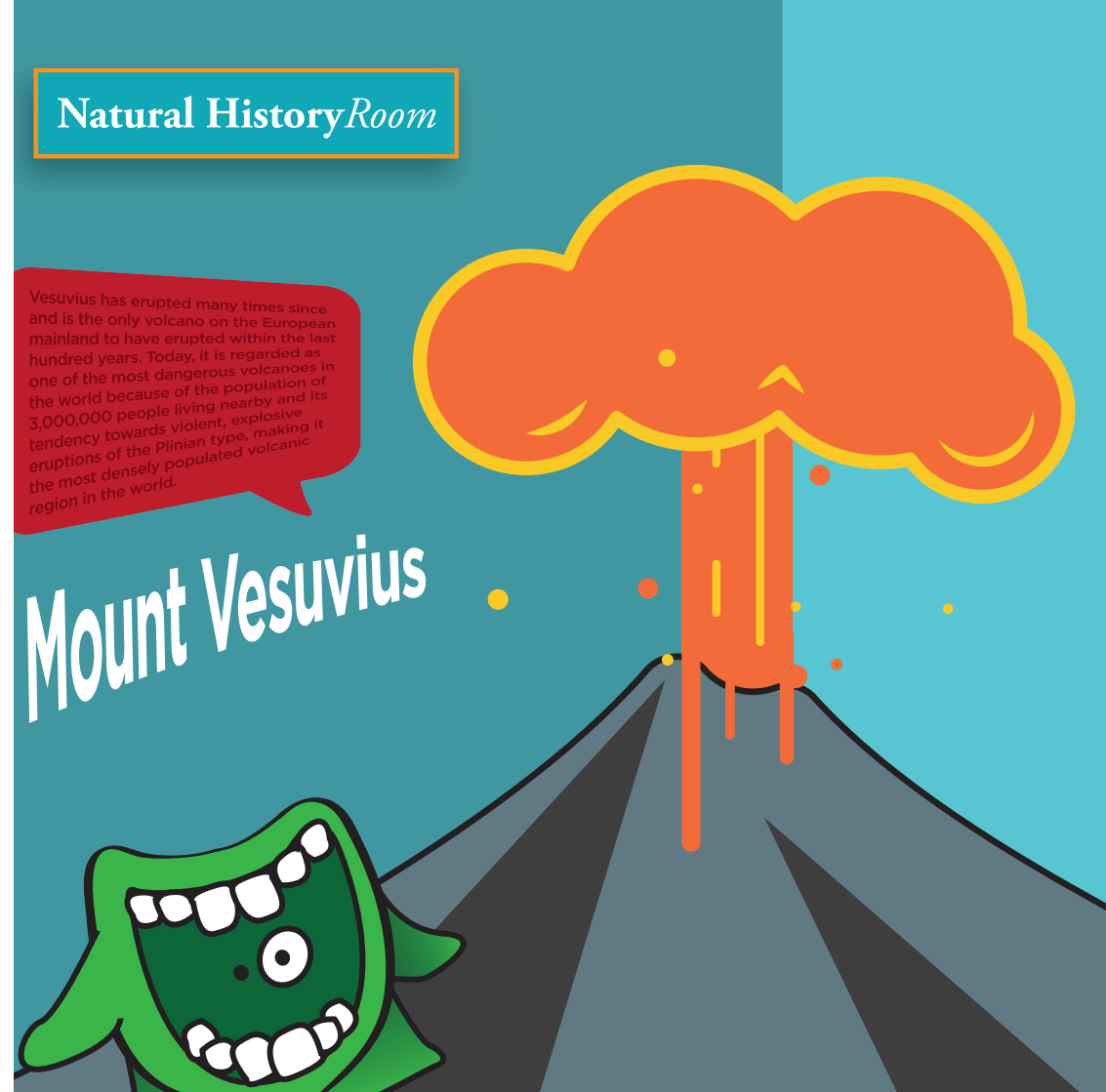
Megabyte likes mega explosions! This is why his favourite part of the museum is the Natural History Room where he learns all about volcanoes!

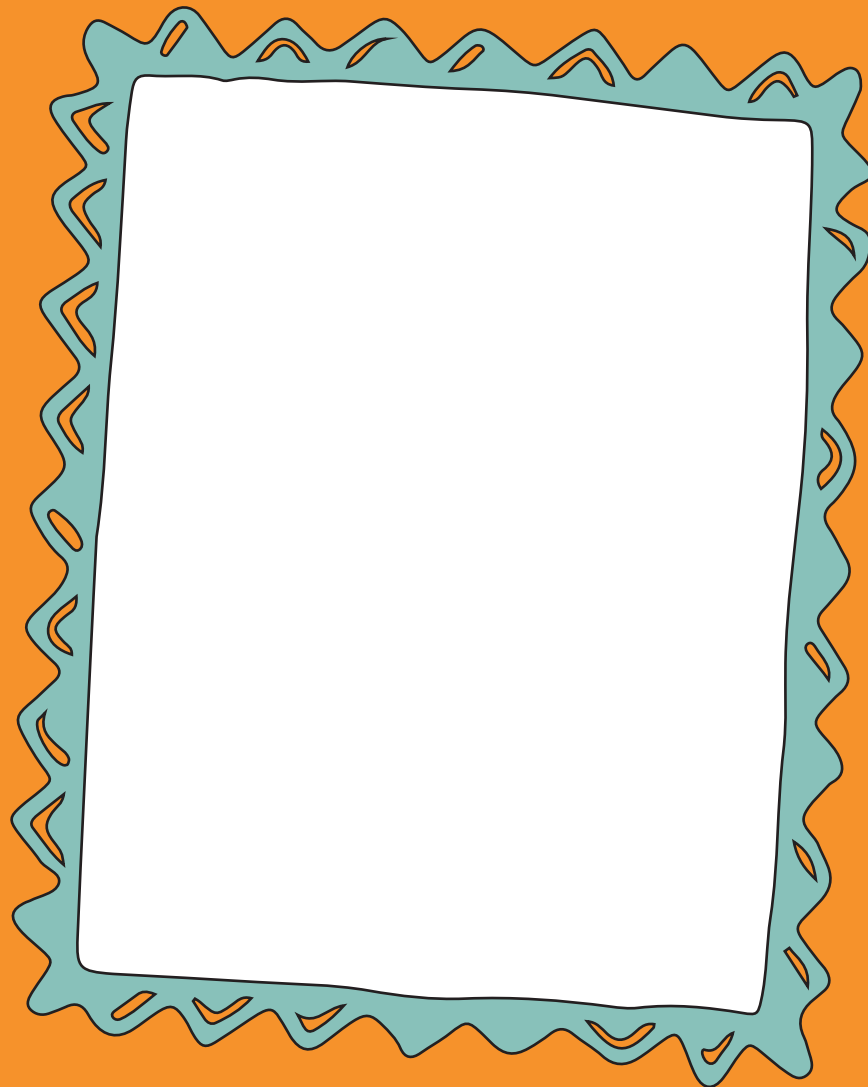
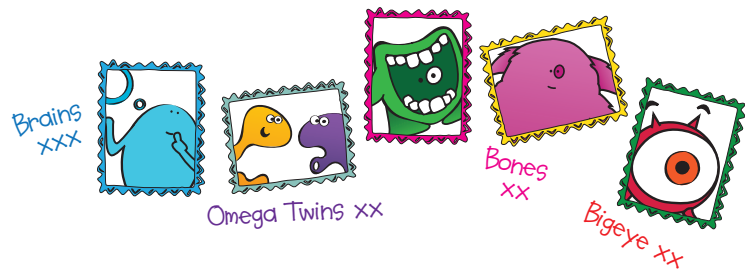

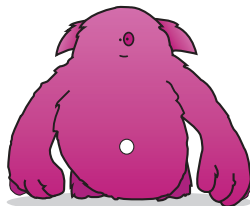
